Design that dives into the future

When izzy+ founder Chuck Saylor decided to create the Nemo project, he knew he wanted to give plenty of creative freedom to longtime izzy+ collaborator, Joey Ruiter.

Opening up the design process to a broader conversation was also important. That's why concept designs for the Nemo Bar and Trellis were brought to NeoCon in 2010 and 2011, where people could try them out.



"Something great happens when you get a chance to show concepts to the public," Ruiter says. "If you take a design and make it into a product right away, it's a lot harder to do something really new and innovative."

After absorbing two years' worth of feedback, the polished versions of the Bar and Trellis were introduced at NeoCon 2012, where they earned a Best of NeoCon® Gold Award. In November 2012, Nemo Bar and Trellis was named an honoree for Interior Design Best of Year 2012, Contract/Desking and Systems category.






Take the one-sided Nemo Trellis and add some Harter Olivia seating and Shapes Tables to create mini-meetup zones.



The Nemo Trellis provides a sense of enclosure and privacy for one individual or several people at a time.








standing-height bar


